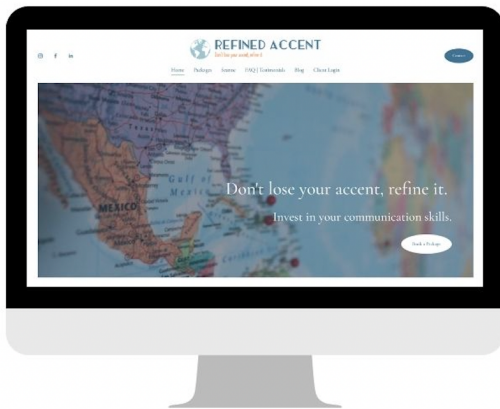

Creating a QR Code

Hover your camera over the QR code to redirect you to a website page.

QR stands for Quick Response. A QR code is simply a barcode that is easily readable with a digital device. You can use the camera app on your phone and this little QR code redirects to a website. For marketing purposes alone this is amazing. Why not put it on your business cards and make flyers that contain less information but when someone scans your QR code they can be directed to your website and can explore from there.
